

## **Demand Full Cleanup of Radioactive & Toxic Contamination at Hunters Point Shipyard Superfund Site!**

**Join Greenaction & Bayview Hunters Point residents in challenging the Navy and USEPA's cover-up and inadequate cleanup of radioactive and toxic pollution at the Hunters Point Naval Shipyard on Wednesday, February 8, 2017 at 5:30 pm.**

The Navy has set this event up as an "Open House" - a format designed to prevent questions being asked and answered in front of the whole audience.

We plan on challenging the Navy and EPA and holding them accountable on Tetra Tech (the Navy's contractor) falsifying hundreds of radioactive soil samples, and on their plans to leave large amounts of radioactive and toxic contamination at the site, near the waterfront threatened by rising sea levels and next to where thousands of people will live, work and play.
