Greenaction for Health and Environmental Justice seeks an experienced organizer for a full time **Environmental Justice Youth and Community Organizer** based in the San Francisco Bay Area.

The organizer will join our diverse and experienced staff in working with community and coalition partners in campaigns, policy initiatives and projects on a range of issues to protect the health and environment of low-income and working class communities impacted by climate change, pollution, environmental racism and injustice.

Job responsibilities:

- Lead and expand Greenaction's Youth Environmental and Climate Justice Leadership Program and youth organizing in frontline urban, rural and indigenous communities
- Coordinate Greenaction's social media work
- Develop fact sheets, advocacy materials, toolkits, action alerts, op-eds, blog posts, and social media content for community/public education and outreach activities
- Approximately 20% time will be spent on grant/funding proposals and donor engagement
- Additional duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Strong commitment to environmental, social, economic, and racial justice.
- At least 2 years of community organizing, campaign, and/or advocacy experience.
- Strategic thinker with short and long-term program development experience.
- Excellent project management skills with experience overseeing project tracking processes, prioritizing and maintaining project schedules and working effectively under tight deadlines.
- Self-motivated, able to work independently as well as in teams in a dynamic, fast-paced environment.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills and ability to work with diverse residents, organizations, and government agencies.
