

Greenaction is filing a lawsuit against the Navy and USEPA in support of the demands of Bayview Hunters Point residents for a Full and Proper Cleanup of all Radioactive and Toxic Waste at the Hunters Point Shipyard Superfund Site

Objective: Greenaction is initiating legal action against the Navy and USEPA to mandate comprehensive retesting and full remediation (cleanup) of all radioactive and toxic waste at the Shipyard Superfund Site.

Significance: Despite community appeals, the Navy and EPA have refused to require a complete cleanup of toxic and radioactive waste at the Shipyard, as they plan to leave some contamination capped even though rising sea levels and rising groundwater will eventually flood and spread the contamination into neighborhoods and the Bay. This lawsuit aims to enforce their duty to safeguard public health and the environment.

Important to Know: This legal action seeks environmental justice, not financial compensation, and will not affect other claims residents may have against the Navy and the government entities.

Additional Benefits: A successful lawsuit will help protect community health and could create job opportunities through increased cleanup efforts.
