WHITE MESA UTES SAY "NO TO URANIUM"

Greetings from Utah, where Greenaction is on the frontlines with tribal members of White Mesa Concerned Community and the Ute Mountain Ute Tribe. The fight against Energy Fuels' uranium mill/dump is heating up, and the Tribe and its members are fighting to protect their health, environment, culture, and sacred sites from pollution and destruction.

On October 4<sup>th</sup>, Greenaction joined with 20 tribal members and dozens of allies in an inspiring rally on the steps of the Utah State Capitol in Salt Lake City (pictured above) to demand the closure and cleanup of Energy Fuels' uranium mill (and dump) located next to the White Mesa Ute Community and near the Bears Ears National Monument. The facility is the only uranium mill in the U.S. and is becoming an international radioactive dump.
