



### Greenaction & Bayview Hunters Point Residents Challenge Polluters, US Navy, and Government Agencies: Our Health is Not for Sale!

The campaign by Greenaction and residents demanding a full cleanup of radioactive and toxic waste at the Hunters Point Shipyard Superfund Site has forced the Navy and government agencies to finally consider the scientific reality that climate change-induced sea level and groundwater rise will flood and spread the contamination unless it is properly cleaned up. Our lawsuit and community campaign are keeping the pressure on! We also continue campaigns against Martin Marietta, Darling, Prologis, and other dirty industries being allowed to pollute by regulatory agencies and City Hall.

### Stop Pollution from the Avenal Regional Landfill!

The mostly Latino/a and Spanish-speaking residents are demanding an end to air pollution, noxious odors, and rat infestation from the giant Avenal Regional Landfill in California's Central Valley. Every day hundreds of diesel trucks dump garbage and contaminated materials at this problem-plagued solid waste landfill located next to low-income housing and community businesses. Greenaction is working with residents and their new community group CARE (and the Central California Environmental Justice Network) to hold the company and government agencies accountable.

# On the Frontlines with Ute Mountain Ute Tribe & White Mesa Ute Community: "Stop Energy Fuels' Uranium Mill/Dump in Utah!"

Greenaction staff and board members joined with the White Mesa Ute Community, Ute Mountain Ute Tribe, and allies on October 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> for a regional networking conference and the annual White Mesa Spiritual Walk and Protest against Energy Fuels' uranium mill and dump. We continue carrying out our major commitment to the Ute people in this campaign to stop the Energy Fuels' facility from becoming an international radioactive dump – and to support Navajo/Dine, Havasupai, and other indigenous people in their campaigns to stop more uranium mining and to get contamination cleaned up properly.



### Greenaction Youth Academy Program Expands!

We are excited to announce that Greenaction's Youth and Adult Environmental & Climate Justice Leadership Academy programs are expanding. ### Greenaction & Quechan Indian Tribe Launch New Air Quality Campaign

Greenaction is excited to be launching a new air quality project with the Quechan Indian Tribe and the grassroots tribal member organization Ah Mut Pipa Foundation. We first worked with the Quechan in the late 1990's in the campaign that defeated the proposed Ward Valley nuclear waste dump in the Mojave Desert. In the last three years we worked closely with the Quechan in their successful campaign that defeated two cyanide leach gold mine projects proposed near their reservation near Yuma, Arizona and Winterhaven, California. Now we are starting a new project featuring community air monitoring, Youth and Adult Environmental Justice Leadership programs, and community education and civic engagement on air pollution issues including diesel truck emissions, pesticide exposure, and disposal of California toxic waste at a solid waste landfill in Yuma, AZ.
