Protesting Energy Fuels' Uranium Mines near the Grand Canyon and Moab, Utah & Uranium Mill/Dump next to the White Mesa Ute Community!
Greenaction joins the White Mesa Ute Community, Ute Mountain Ute Tribe, Navajo and Pueblo community groups, and the Havasupai Tribe as we escalate campaigns against uranium mining, transportation, and dumping of radioactive materials at the Energy Fuels mill/dump next to White Mesa in southern Utah. We continue our major involvement in the campaign to close Energy Fuels' uranium mill/dump that has become an international radioactive dump, next to the White Mesa Ute Community. We support the Havasupai's effort to close the Pinyon Plain uranium mine near the Grand Canyon - and we are all opposing the new uranium mine at La Sal in Utah. Together, we oppose Trump's reckless push for more uranium mining and nuclear power.



Demand Health & Justice for Laytonville, California

Residents of the small northern California town of Laytonville including tribal members living on the Cahto Rancheria continue to suffer alarming rates of illness and death likely caused by toxic contamination from the old Mendocino County solid waste landfills. Greenaction continues supporting the people fighting to get residents out of harm's way, and to pressure the government to clean up and stop more pollution from harming the community and environment.

Stop Pollution from the Avenal Regional Landfill!

Greenaction and Avenal residents led by their community group Avenal CARE are demanding an end to air pollution, noxious odors, diesel truck pollution, and rat infestation from the giant Avenal Regional Landfill in this Spanish-speaking farmworker town in California's Central Valley. Every day hundreds of diesel trucks dump garbage and contaminated materials at this problem-plagued solid waste landfill located next to low-income housing and community businesses.

Greenaction & Quechan Tribe Launch New Air Quality Campaign and Leadership Academy Programs for Youth and Adults

Over the last few years we helped the Quechan Indian Tribe and tribal members defeat two cyanide leach gold mine projects proposed near their reservation in Winterhaven, California. We are now starting a new air quality project with the tribe and the grassroots tribal member organization Ah Mut Pipa Foundation. Our project includes community air monitoring, Youth and Adult Environmental Justice Leadership programs, community education and civic engagement on air pollution issues including mining, diesel truck emissions, and pesticide exposure. Academy programs will empower residents to have the knowledge, skills, and confidence to be effective activists and leaders in their communities impacted by pollution.

Greenaction & Bayview Hunters Point Residents Challenge Polluters, US Navy, and Government Agencies: Our Health is Not for Sale!

The fight for environmental justice in Bayview Hunters Point continues! The campaign by Greenaction and community groups to demand a full cleanup of all radioactive and toxic waste at the Hunters Point Shipyard Superfund Site has forced the Navy and government agencies to finally consider the scientific reality that climate change-induced sea level and groundwater rise will flood contamination unless it is properly cleaned up. We also continue our campaigns against Martin Marietta, Darling, Prologis and other dirty industries being allowed to pollute by regulatory agencies and City Hall. Join our monthly Bayview Hunters Point Environmental Justice Task Force meetings.

Rallying Against Cuts to Climate Action Planning in San Francisco

Greenaction has a history of holding the San Francisco Department of the Environment accountable for their responsibility to address community environmental concerns and protect the health and safety of the environment and community in San Francisco. In late February we joined hundreds of people in a rally at City Hall against the proposed massive cuts to the San Francisco Environment Department Budget.
