



All Hands on Deck to Defend the Health and Safety of Bayview Hunters Point & San Francisco Bay From Radioactive and Toxic Waste

Toxic and radioactive waste at the Hunters Point Naval Shipyard Superfund Site continues to poison residents and the environment, while the Navy tries to cover it up. On June 24th, Greenaction and the Marie Harrison Community Foundation mobilized 29 groups and more than 150 people on the steps of City Hall to demand retesting and a full cleanup of contamination with full community oversight, and health reparations for residents harmed by the pollution. The Navy's cleanup plans would leave toxic and radioactive waste buried along the shoreline where San Francisco plans a massive redevelopment project, putting the current and future resident's health at extreme risk.



STOP PROPOSED AI DATA CENTERS!

Greenaction has responded to a request for help from residents of the Kings County, California towns of Hanford and Lemoore to help defeat plans for several proposed AI data centers including at the Lemoore Naval Air Station and at the Kings Fair Grounds. Residents are concerned about harmful impacts of data centers including air pollution and water use. Greenaction leaders will join residents and other experts in speaking at a large town hall meeting to be held on August 28th in Hanford. Greenaction is also advising Quechan Tribe members who are also facing a giant data center proposal on their reservation.

Protesting Energy Fuels' Uranium Mill/Dump next to the White Mesa Ute Community and the Uranium Mines near the Grand Canyon and Moab, Utah!

On May 16th, Greenaction organized a successful protest with White Mesa Ute Community/Ute Mountain Ute Tribe members, Navajo Nation members and allies at La Sal Junction in southern Utah to raise awareness about Energy Fuels' facilities including the uranium mill/dump next to White Mesa and the company's uranium mines at La Sal and near the Grand Canyon. The mines and mill threaten public health, cultural and sacred sites, and the environment. Join us to demand closure of Energy Fuels' facilities. Tribal members and Greenaction are mobilizing for the 10th Annual White Mesa Spiritual Walk & Protest on October 17th.

Stop Pollution from the Avenal Regional Landfill!

Greenaction and Avenal residents led by their community group Avenal CARE continue to organize and advocate for stronger regulatory oversight and enforcement against pollution violations at the Avenal Regional Landfill in this farmworker town in California's Central Valley. Residents are outraged about air pollution, noxious odors, diesel truck traffic, and quality-of-life impacts affecting the community. Through our organizing, residents are participating in local and state advocacy efforts, including speaking at public meetings, engaging with elected officials, and supporting legislation aimed at increasing protections for communities impacted by landfills. Every day, hundreds of diesel trucks dump garbage and contaminated materials at the landfill located next to low-income housing and community businesses.
